Dear Massage School Applicant,

Enclosed is everything you need to register for our 750 Hour Massage Therapy Program. **We are the school of choice in Alaska for Oriental Healing Massage and Bodywork**, and you will see that we are much more than just a Massage School – we are a healing journey. You will gain a very strong foundation in the way the human body works, massage therapy, acupressure and coming into health. Our school places a very high emphasis on ensuring that you are successful in this field. After you graduate and become a Licensed Massage Therapist, we have several work opportunities available to those interested through Massage Now. We also offer a full line of Advanced Massage Therapy and Oriental Medicine courses to further benefit your career, including programs in TuiNa Medical Acupressure Massage, Medical QiGong Energy Healing, Thai Massage, Chinese Herbs, 5-Element Nutrition, Essential Oil Certification, and more.

How the program works:

- We offer 2 schedules to fit various time and financial needs.

Program D: Full-time days – Mon, Tue, Wed 9:00am-4:00pm (8 months)

Program C: Part-time days - Take up to 3 years to complete all classes

- **Program D:** This is the shortest time period, 8 months. Students should be ready to apply a time commitment during non-class hours to watch weekly online videos and also to complete the required student clinic hours.

- **Program C:** If a flexible schedule best suits your needs this program is for you. Within certain guidelines, program C may be eligible for some but not all types of funding (talk with us about details). We recommend starting with BioScience as your first classes. Classes are offered twice each year and you have 3 years to finish all 750 hours.
 - You must take the BioScience course in order to take any hands-on massage classes so we recommend that you take BioScience first, or at the same time as a hands-on massage class. It is important to know the muscles and bones you are touching when doing massage.

How to Apply and Register:

1. One of our Recruitment Officers will guide you completely through the registration process, including the application kit, financial aid assistance, and orientation. If you need a Recruitment Officer to work with, contact us at 907-279-0135.
2. The earlier you apply for financial aid the better. Some agencies will not approve funding if you are already attending classes that have started. **See the next page for the types of funding we accept.**
3. Payment:
 - Enclose payment for your course tuition. Acceptable forms are cash, check (payable to AK Institute) or MC/Visa/Discover/AMEX.
 - If you have requested our internal payment plan you must put at least 25% down. Your Admissions Officer will assist you with a Payment Plan Agreement which must be completed and signed.
 - If you have applied for or will be receiving financial aid write in the name of the agency which will be funding your tuition and the total amount.
4. The Massage Therapy Program Director will review your application after which you will receive a letter of acceptance and a shopping list of textbooks and supplies, acceptance pending specific items, or denial to the program.

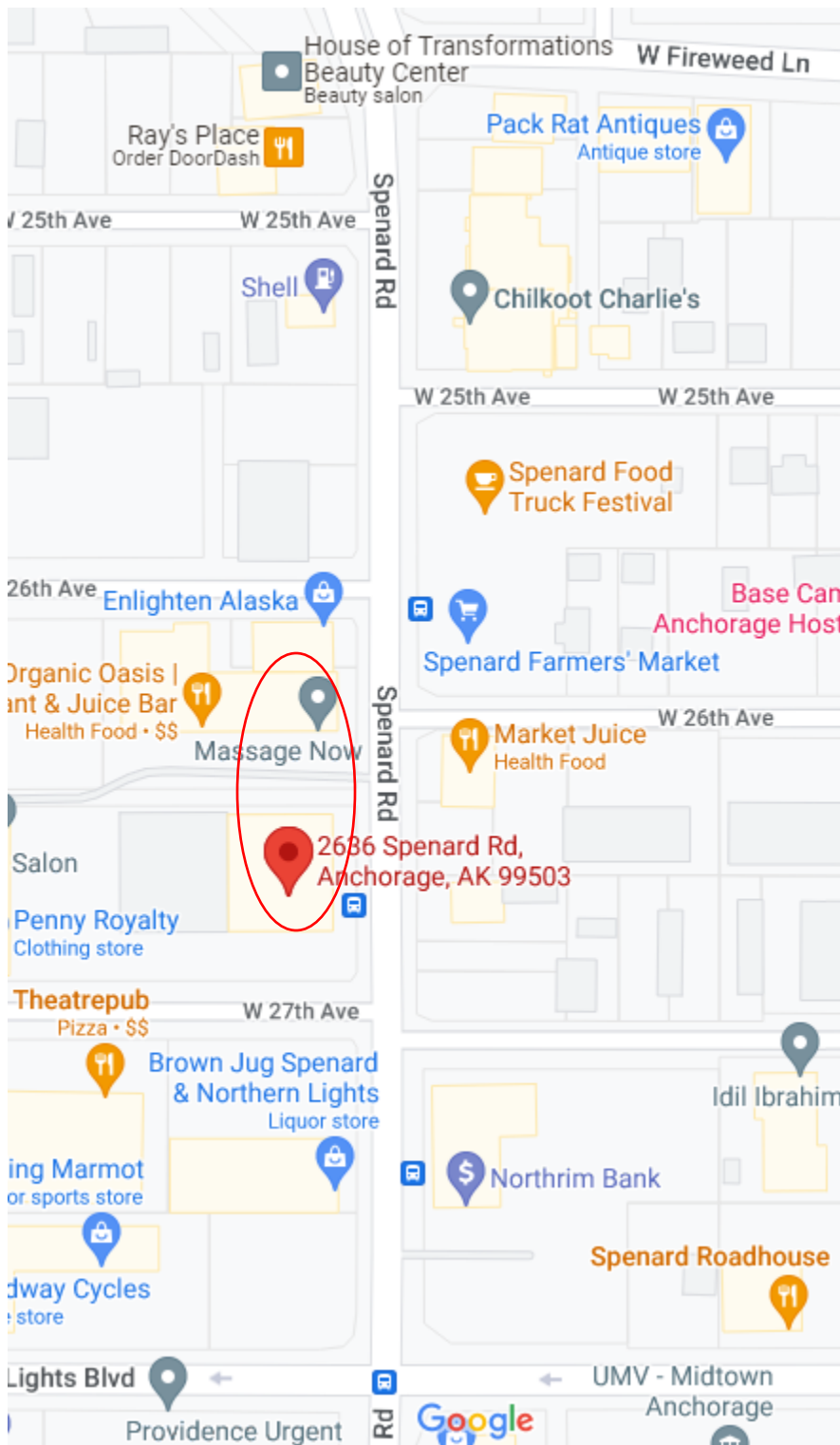

Important – Read and sign at the end of this section

Massage Therapy Program applicants must be aware of the licensing requirements for the State of Alaska in order to work in the field of massage therapy after graduation. If there are any requirements, particularly in the area of crimes and convictions that are of concern to be a barrier in becoming licensed, your application to our program will only be approved if we deem that you are a successful candidate to pursue licensing, or you acknowledge that you are aware you may not be approved for a license in the State of Alaska and you wish to apply for reasons other than becoming licensed.

MESSAGE THERAPY LICENSING REQUIREMENTS FOR THE STATE OF ALASKA

- Completion of a course of study of at least 625 hours of in-class supervised instruction and clinical work from an approved massage school, with specific educational requirements broken down. (Our program meets this requirement, and we supply your transcript and education break down to the Massage Board when you apply for your license).
- Verification of having passed the MBLEx national exam (NOTE: The MBLEx exam is only available in written English and Spanish. Interpreters are not allowed. It can be taken by students towards the end of our program or after graduation.)
- Have been fingerprinted and passed a national criminal history record check. (We will go through this process together during our Ethics and Laws class.)
- Have a current CPR certification and completion of at least 2 hours of safety education in bloodborne pathogens and universal precautions. (NOTE: This training is offered through our school via an outside approved agency. The cost of approximately \$90-\$115 is not included in tuition. Applicants may opt to take training from any approved agency of their choice.)
- Has not been convicted of, or pled guilty or no contest to, a crime involving moral turpitude, or who has been convicted of, or pled guilty or no contest to, a crime involving moral turpitude if the board finds that the conviction does not affect the applicant's ability to practice competently and safely. The State of Alaska Massage Therapy Board's definition of moral turpitude is:
 - homicide;
 - manslaughter;
 - assault
 - stalking;
 - kidnapping;
 - sexual assault;
 - sexual abuse of a minor;
 - unlawful exploitation of a minor, including possession or distribution of child pornography;
 - indecent exposure;
 - unlawful distribution or possession for distribution of a controlled substance;
 - prostitution;
 - sex trafficking
 - murder;

- human trafficking;
- criminal sexual conduct;
- incest;
- robbery;
- extortion;
- forgery;
- theft;
- endangering the welfare of a child;
- endangering the welfare of a vulnerable adult;
- reckless endangerment.

Questions on the State of Alaska Application for Massage Therapy License you must answer: The following questions must be answered. “Yes” answers may not automatically result in license denial. If you answer “Yes” to any of the questions, you will be asked to explain dates and circumstances on a separate piece of paper, signed and dated, and send any supporting documents that are applicable (court records, judgments, charging documents, etc.) to the Massage Therapy Board attached to your license application. Applications submitted without the appropriate attachments will be considered incomplete and will not be processed.

1 Have you been convicted of a crime or are you currently charged with committing a crime? For purposes of this question, “crime” includes a misdemeanor, felony, or a military offense, including a conviction involving driving under the influence (DUI) or driving while intoxicated (DWI), driving without a license, reckless driving, or driving with a suspended or revoked license. “Convicted” includes having been found guilty by verdict of a judge or jury, having entered a plea of guilty, nolo contendere or no contest, or having been given probation, a suspended imposition of sentence, or a fine.

PAYMENT OF CHILD SUPPORT AND STUDENT LOANS, to be aware of in order to maintain a viable Massage Therapy license:

If the Alaska Child Support Enforcement Division has determined that you are in arrears on child support, or if the Alaska Commission on Postsecondary Education has determined you are in loan default, you may be issued a nonrenewable temporary license valid for 150 days. Contact Child Support Services at (907) 269-6900 or the Postsecondary Education office at (907) 465-2962 or 1-800-441-2962 to resolve payment issues.
